C. How you can reign in life!

1. Reign over your own mind and thoughts!

"For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind." (2 Timothy 1; NKJ)

2. Reign over your _____!

3. Reign over your _____!

"All things are lawful for me, but all things are not helpful. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any. Foods for the stomach and the stomach for foods, but God will destroy both it and them. Now the body is not for sexual immorality but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body." (1 Corinthians 6:12-13; NKJ)

4. Reign over your _____.

"Speak these things, exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no one despise you." (Titus 2:15; NKJ)

6. Exercise _____ power to abound in _____!

"Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." (Romans 15:13; NKJ)

7. Exercise Holy Spirit power in the _____!

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." (Acts 1:8; NKJ)
