3. Build peaceful relationships by listening, understanding, and dialogue.

"Be of the same mind toward one another. ..." (v16)

4. Build peaceful relationships by ruthlessly

"... Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion." (v16)

5. Build peaceful relationships by refusing to " or " ".

"Repay no one evil for evil. ..." (v17)

6. Build peaceful relationships by finding ______ ground.

"...Have regard for good things in the sight of all men." (v17)
