"Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith apart from the deeds of the law." (Romans 3:28; NKJ)

I. Lay a foundation of faith!

"(as it is written, 'I have made you a father of many nations') in the presence of Him whom he believed—(v17a)

- II. Understand what kinds of miracles God can do for you!
- "... God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did;" (v17b)
- A. Resurrection Miracles! God gives life to things that are dead!
- B. Creation Miracles! God creates something out of nothing!

III. How to trust God for a miracle!

"... who, contrary to hope, in hope believed, so that he became the father of many nations, according to what was spoken, 'So shall your descendants be.' And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform. And therefore 'it was accounted to him for righteousness." (Romans 4:18-22; NKJ)

- A. Claim the promise(s) of God for your life!
- B. Commit to be obedient to God!
- C. Be patient and persistent in prayer!

"He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief," (v 20)

No longer shall your name be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I have made you a father of many nations. I will make you exceedingly fruitful; and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come from you." (Genesis 17:1-6; NKJ)

"God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did; (Romans 4:17b; NKJ)

"... Then Jesus said to them plainly, 'Lazarus is dead. And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, that you may believe. Nevertheless let us go to him." (John 11:1-15; NKJ)
