## Prayer Power Statements Cry Out! 40 Day Prayer Campaign Matthew 6:9-13 Sunday, September 27, 2020

"In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors. And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen." (Matthew 6:9-13; NKJ)

## Power Statement #1. Father, I \_\_\_\_\_\_ for Your \_\_\_\_\_\_ to come!

Your kingdom come.

"And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the Consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. "You ask [God for something] and do not receive it, because you ask with wrong motives [out of selfishness or with an unrighteous agenda], so that [when you get what you want] you may spend it on your [hedonistic] desires." (James 4:3; AMP)

## Power Statement #2. Father, I \_\_\_\_\_\_.

"My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing." (James 1:2-4; NKJ)
