"Yours is the kingdom!"

"In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" (Matthew 3:1-2; NKJ)

"And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people." (Matthew 4:23; NKJ)

"Then those men, when they had seen the sign that Jesus did, said, 'This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world.' Therefore when Jesus perceived that they were about to come and take Him by force to make Him king, He departed again to the mountain by Himself alone. And when they found Him on the other side of the sea, they said to Him, 'Rabbi, when did You come here?' Jesus answered

them and said, 'Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled.'" (John 6:14-15, 25-26; NKJ)

"Therefore I ... do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, ... that you may know ... what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, ..." (Ephesians 1:15-21; NKJ)

"Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,..." (Ephesians 3:20; NKJ)

"But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us. ..." (2 Corinthians 4:7-10; NKJ)
